Send State Dues and the State Courtesy/Hospitality Fee (\$11.50 per member) with a copy of the H-138 to Terri Thompson, State Treasurer and send the State Scholarship Fee (\$4 per member) to Crissie Singleton, VP for Scholarship.

A reminder that On Time Reporting earns a Pearl at International and checks off one part for the Georgia Cornucopia Award given at State Convention. You were 99% ON TIME payment this year. I anticipate 100% in January 2020.

FOCUS: PUERTO RICO

Thanksgiving, Día de Acción de Gracias in Puerto Rico, is a time of gratitude for life, for protection of crops and for giving thanks. It reflects an American legacy Puerto Ricans enthusiastically adopted after in became territory of the United States in the late 19th century.

Before eating, people give thanks for the good things that have happened throughout the year. Families gather to eat pavochón with a side of arroz con gandules, morcilla, pasteles, potato salad and anything else that makes it to the table. The meal ends with a nice dessert. Instead of traditional American pumpkin pie, Puerto Ricans love a good custard for dessert. Tembleque, which means "wiggly" is a cinnamon-coated coconut custard that's a favorite. Just like on the U.S. mainland, shops close, families come together, ridiculous amounts of food get prepared and eaten and families and friends wake up the next day to fight for Black Friday deals.

For many schoolchildren in the island, celebration starts a day prior to Thanksgiving break with the 'Maraton del Pavo' (the turkey marathon). The winner of this race gets a frozen turkey, the next two a frozen whole chicken, and from fourth to tenth place, a live chick. How this part of the celebration came to be? It is unknown, but it seems to point to a charitable custom that stuck thereafter.




