- Chapter Ex Bd meets to draft chapter goals for the coming year (see the Guidance Document/cheat sheet of sample SMART goals sent to each of you after training).
 Review the membership eligibility document, craft a membership plan and be ready to invite new and reinstated members to join in AΔK fun, fellowship, service, education and world understanding.
- Share proposed goals and plans with chapter members and finalize those by the September meeting. Remember to have members update Directory information on the Intl. website at your first meeting and review the Cornerstone at each meeting.
- Review the Chapter Needs Assessment (CNA) sample on the Intl. website & craft responses for all questions.
- Have the membership chairman/VPM log on and complete the CNA prior to October 15.

And last but not least, remember that membership is the responsibility of every chapter member and our mantra for the year is *Each One*, *Reach One*! 
