# Membership Tidbits for the 2024–2026 Biennium CHAPTER NEEDS ASSESSMENT


CHAPTER NEEDS ASSESMENT (CNA) is just another name for CHAPTER GOALS!

The JotForm is now online and due October 15.

Chapter goals are submitted electronically on the CNA JotForm. Log on the Alpha Delta Kappa website, click Members Only and RESOURCE LIBRARY. Then go to Chapter Documents and Forms, Officer's Calendar Deadlines (the first item), CLICK FORM at the end of Oct 15 CNA deadline and the JOT form will come up.

I might suggest you print the training sample and make notes before completing online. This may save you time when typing into the JotForm. Once you finish online, you will want to make a copy for your records when you get the email saying it has been received.

#### **News for Treasurers**


Be on the look out for your treasurer officer packet from Headquarters. It will be emailed to you with important information in early September. All required documents and forms are in the resource library on the international website - www.alphadeltakappa.org. As a new feature, Headquarters has enhanced the officer calendar by highlighting forms that are in the resource library.

Headquarters is also encouraging members to pay International dues online. Invoices will be sent to each member in September. You can have each member in your chapter go to the website to pay, or you can include the fee in your chapter dues, and then you will go and pay International dues for the whole chapter. You will also pay the chapter \$20 ITE fee at the International site.

The first two dates coming up for you are the **October 15** deadline for the 990-N to be submitted to the IRS and a copy sent to me through email and the **November 1** deadline for a copy of your chapter budget to be sent to me. Many of you have done these things early. Thank you!


