



## A New Year of Giving



This is a good idea for the chapter to gather monies for an Altruistic Project over the year.

Send copies to members and add this to your newsletter each month.

**January-** Happy New Year. The president or fraternity education chair brings a common container for the sisters. This person will discuss an altruistic project that is important to your club (like St. Jude's, Adventure Bags, Alzheimer's, or a local altruistic project). This person will tell the sisters we will be gathering money to put into this container at the next meeting.

**February-** At the February meeting, put .25 cents in for each year you have been a member of Alpha Delta Kappa.

**March-** Take your shoe size and multiply it by 10 cents. For example: a size 7 would be \$.70.

**April-** If your hair is gray, pay .25 cents, black- .50 cents, brown- .75 cents, white- .10 cents, blonde- \$1.00, red- \$1.50.

**May-** .25 cents for each letter in the name of your birth state. For example: Georgia would be \$1.75.

**September-** If you were a September bride, pay \$1.00. All other months pay .50 cents. Unmarried??? Take out .10 cents.

**October-** Put in .10 cents for each year of your age. For example: if you are 40 years old, you would pay \$4.00. If you are over the age of 65, you may deduct \$3.00.

**November-** Show your gratitude. Put .25 cents for each sibling you have. If you have a husband, add .10 cents.

**December-** Be your own Santa! Everyone drop in \$2.00

At the end of the year the president or fraternity education chair can add this money up and send it to the right group.
