




Pearls of Service

Directions:

1. Give a snack baggie to each member containing pearls (white beads, marbles, etc), one for each year of her membership in Alpha Delta Kappa.
2. Slip a note inside the snack baggie stating the year of her initiation and the number of years of membership. A member's year of initiation can be found in the membership directory listing on the website.
3. Provide a beautiful clear glass vase to use as a container.
4. The first member reads her note and pours her "pearls" into the container and passes it to the next person.
5. The next person reads her note and adds her "pearls" into the container and passes it to the next person.
6. This continues until all "pearls" have been added to the vase.
7. The FE Chairman reads the notes of those members who are not present and adds their "pearls" to the container.
8. Next, have members estimate how many "pearls" are in the vase which will translate into total years of service in _____ Chapter of Alpha Delta Kappa. The member guessing the closest total number of years is awarded a prize.
9. Closing: Martin Luther King Jr. said it best, "Everyone can be great, because everyone can serve."
